HULL & DECK

The hulls are of GRP construction with balsa core for strength, stiffness and insulation, using high quality materials

The hulls are painted with EPA approved environmentally friendly anti-fouling

The rudders are composite with a stainless steel shaft

Both deck and hull are finished in white gel coat with the trademark Sunsail striping and graphics

The deck has a moulded-in nonskid pattern providing excellent traction

The trampoline net is one piece and firmly secured

The double helmsman seat is located in the hardtop to allow for a 360 degree view around the boat

Removable helmseat spray dodger/windscreen

LPG Gas outlet on stern rail for optional barbeque

The Sunsail 444

The Sunsail 444 is the newest generation of cruising catamarans built by Robertson and Caine and focuses on innovation, performance, and comfort. With an abundance of outdoor space and its generous sail plan, this catamaran is both luxurious and practical. The spacious four double cabin and four head layout plus large saloon and galley gives plenty of room for groups or families. Generous headroom throughout plus substantial storage capacity gives additional space for on board relaxation.

The innovative exterior of the Sunsail 444 features not only a spacious hardtop covered aft cockpit but also a large forward cockpit with access to the saloon providing even more space for relaxing. Her powerboat-style stepped transom enabling easier boarding. Environmental considerations were also central to the design, with solar panels installed on the helm hardtop to charge the on-board batteries. For additional comfort the Sunsail 444 features generator and air conditioning.
