### La Paz


#### NOT THE MEXICO YOU KNOW

- Day 5: Puerto Escondido: Stock up then drive to Loreto with its mouth-watering restaurants.
- Day 6: Isla Santa Catalina: See a giant barrel cactus and fish on the island's coast.
- Day 7: San Jose: Spend the morning in the area exploring the anchorage.
- Day 8: La Paz: Enjoy a swim before breakfast while taking in the sunrise.

#### Weather

With a warm climate and over 300 days of sunshine a year, the average daytime temperature in summer is 95°F while spring, autumn and winter temperatures range from 70°-85°F. At night, temperatures tend to drop off, so bring a jacket for winter evenings.

#### MARVELS OF THE MEDITERRANEAN


